Chicago: June 24-30, 2017

The Who, What, When, Where, Why and How:

WHO Should Sign Up? The Faithful, Available, Teachable

This trip is open to all students who are currently in 9th-12th grade. We have a limited amount of spots that have already been reserved for our group. It is a very conservative number though. If we have a great turnout we will need to see if we can add more. I will also need some parents or responsible adults to attend this trip with me. We will need a handful of adult men and women who are willing to help me. If we do not get the adult support for this trip we will be forced to have to only take so many teens, so please check your calendar. **YOU KNOW YOU WANT TO COME!!!** And honestly, every parent ought to go at least once with their teen. It will be a memorable experience you will share together for the rest of your lives.

Students currently in grades 9-12th who want to participate in this trip must understand the work that will be doing. The work that we will be given will be strenuous. But the reward of knowing that you contributed to assist someone who needs help will be significant. Keeping this in mind, any student who wants to be considered for the Chicago trip must do 3 things to qualify for official CONSIDERATION to participate:

- A.) Fill out the **ENTIRE** application by Sunday, February 19, 2017.
- B.) Turn in a \$100 non-refundable deposit (pending your acceptance to the team). **Total cost is \$500.00**
- C.) Commit to being active in our Student Ministries if you are not already involved. We want you to begin experiencing missions here first and get to know other students before we head out for our trip!

After these 3 steps are accomplished, a tentative decision will be made with the Student Ministries Leadership Team on the participation of each student. If there are any concerns or questions we will direct them privately to the parents and the teen in question.

WHO? (host organization)

Praying Pelican Missions is a short-term international missions organization serving the needs of indigenous local churches, pastors, and communities around the world. We set up and lead mission trips for churches, small groups, families, and individuals from North America, continually expanding and strengthening a network of pastors and communities both abroad and in the United States. Each year as lives are touched and hearts are transformed, there is an increasing number of pastors, churches, and communities inviting mission teams to serve alongside them through Praying Pelican Missions. We are continually amazed to witness and be part of God's movement in the world, from Chicago to Costa Rica to South Africa and everywhere in between.

Prayer ministry in the city has been a highlight for our past teams and it can be for yours as well as our Praying Pelican Missions staff and local leaders help your mission trip participants see the need of each community you visit. As you pray with intentionality, your groups' eyes will be opened to how God sees these specific needs and hears the prayers of His people.

Our staff will work closely with you to address the potential social justice issues you will likely encounter throughout your trip in advance so you can choose how each issue is presented to your Chicago mission trip team. Chicago is a city that has so many people who are in need of Jesus.

WHEN?

June 24-30th. Departure and arrival times will be solidified as we get closer to the date.

WHERE?

PPM will put us up in a school or church where we sleep and have our meeting times. As we draw closer to the trip I will be able to give you an exact location of where we will be staying.

WHY?

As Christians, we are called to serve God's children. In Matthew 25, Christ tells us that when we are serving one another, we are in essence serving Him. Come serve and learn from the body of Christ in Chicago!

HOW? (Transportation)

All traveling will be done by 15-passanger vans and a cargo van to and from Chicago. While we are in the city we will be using the vans to get around.

COMMITMENT FORM

By signing this form, I am indicating that I would like to participate in the Epiphany United Methodist Church Senior High Student Missions Trip to Chicago on June 24-30, 2017, subject to my acceptance for participation and my continuing demonstration of the spiritual maturity and gifts necessary for the mission.

I will also endeavor to secure the funds necessary to participate in the trip. I understand that all support checks and payment for the trip that I make should be made payable to Epiphany United Methodist Church, or endorsed over to Epiphany, and all monies will be recorded in a personal student support account set up in my name. I understand that this account will be established with my payment of the \$100 non-refundable deposit (due no later than Sunday, February 19th).

I fully understand that I have a **financial obligation** to the team. I understand that any and all funds placed in my account that go over the amount I need to raise will be transferred to an account of another person going on the trip. I also agree to participate in all fundraisers for the trip, and that all the funds I raise at those events will go generally towards the Chicago trip sponsorship by Epiphany United Methodist Church, and not to my personal account.

I also have a **moral obligation** to act and behave as a Christian within the youth group. Any decision to ask a student to step down from going on the Chicago trip is solely left up to the Student Ministries leadership team. If for some reason I am asked to step down from the team I understand that none of the funds I have raised will be returned to me but will remain contributions to Epiphany United Methodist Church which it may use for the Chicago trip, other youth ministries, and/or other ministries of Epiphany United Methodist Church as it may deem appropriate in its sole discretion. I also agree to seek out forgiveness, restoration and repentance with any party I have wronged. If I am asked to step down, I hereby waive any and all interest I may have in the trip account established in my name and to any refund thereof, in whole or in part, whether contributed by me or by others on my behalf; and further hereby release Epiphany United Methodist Church, its pastors, staff and members, with respect to any and all claims I may have, if any, in connection with that determination.

Finally, I have a **team obligation**. I understand by signing this commitment form that I agree to participate in any and all fundraising, training, reading, memorization, and special meetings that may be required to properly prepare for the ministries and services I am expected to perform. We will have approximately 4-5 meetings between March through June. There may also be a Mission Training Day in May prior to our trip. These meetings will help us to bond as a team and prepare us for the trip. I also have an obligation to abide by the rules and boundaries set forth by the adult leaders of Epiphany United Methodist Church. I will contribute to the team through maintaining a Christ-like attitude and a positive team spirit all throughout the trip. I will forgo the "comforts" of my regular life in order to serve others during the time of this trip. I will work hard to maintain team unity throughout this adventure together. I will honor Jesus Christ above all in my actions, attitudes and behavior.
