

Key Feedback from Epiphany Pulse Checks (EPC)

EPC Stats

- 189 people (54% of congregation)
- 110 in groups + 69 online + 10 leadership/SPRC
- 53% traditional, 47% contemporary
- Average age: 56
- Range: 25-79
- Average years at Epiphany: 11
- Range: 6 months - 24 years

Key Feedback for Next Steps

1. Develop a timeline to bring back Children's Moments
2. We need to be more intentional in learning members names and getting to know one another including pastoral team.
3. Plan to reduce announcements in the services by providing alternate ways to communicate
4. Bring back traditional Methodism to the contemporary service (Lord's prayer, pastoral congregational prayer w/names and joys/concerns, etc.)
5. Go back to discussing full 5 expectations of members. Talk about them Frequently

Staff Response To Implement Next Steps

1. Children at the Services. Working on the specific details of implementing and working through flow with worship services. Start Children's Moment Weekend of April 13th and April 14th
2. Quarterly Food & Fellowship Meetings. Potential new members, recent new members, and other congregational members will meet at the church quarterly to get to know one another and share stories and answer questions about Epiphany.
3. Key Announcements will be communicated through email, social media, welcome center/sign up boards, and bulletins. Will focus on cutting down the number of announcements shared during worship services.
4. More traditions in contemporary services. Examples of bring back Lords Prayer and Pastoral Prayers.
5. More emphasis on communicating our 5 commitments. **Epiphany is about creating a passion for Christ, love for all, and change in our world!** Our commitment as members is to **1) Worship 2) Grow in Our Faith 3) Serve 4) Giving Financially to Local Church and Missions 5) Invite Others to**

Meet and Know Jesus Christ. Sermon Series in May will discuss our 5 commitments. There will also be more language about our 5 commitments during sermons on a regular basis.

3. We love our Music & Music Leaders (Both Contemporary & Traditional)
4. Keep the communication lines open (through good and bad)
